## WHO WE ARE

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The Skeletal Genomics Unit at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) is a group of genetics specialists studying rare and undiagnosed skeletal disorders hoping to learn more about these conditions including the natural history, etiology, and opportunities for future treatments.

## CURRENTLY RECRUITING

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Our protocol, **Study of Skeletal Disorders** (ClinicalTrials.gov ID NCT05031507), is now linked to **A Natural History Study of Metabolic Sizing in Health and Disease** (ClinicalTrials.gov ID NCT05398783). This collaboration offers the opportunity for our skeletal dysplasia population to undergo a series of measurements examining body composition, body surface area, and metabolic rate.

**We are seeking individuals with short stature as a result of a diagnosed skeletal dysplasia to co-enroll in our two protocols to help develop more accurate measurements in the short statured population.**
