Founder's Prize: We encourage junior members / colleagues to submit abstracts for the Founder's Prize. Entrants need not be members of the SDG, although we expect one supervisor / collaborator will be and will attend the meeting to support their trainee. The prize of up to £500 (at the Committee's discretion) is awarded annually to a junior member (SpR or clinical / research fellow) for the best short paper / project presented at the SDG meeting. Newly appointed consultants are also eligible, provided they present work completed prior to their consultant appointment. Presentations are judged on individual merit, but judges consider the level of support received. The Committee may (at their discretion) award two prizes of £500 each (or share the prize) if there are two speakers of equal merit. Abstracts should be no longer than 200 words (including title, excluding authors/ affiliations) submitted to Nicky by 5pm 10.11.23 Nickybishop66@gmail.com.
